Whew! I've registered! Now what happens?

What's the League doing?

Beginning in August for Fall and March for Spring, your Region is organizing teams and beginning the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

When do the teams see their team rosters?

Rosters and schedules should be posted by September 1 for Fall and March 1 for Spring.

When do the players get called?

Teams may begin practice on or after August 27th for Fall and April 8th for Spring. We ask all coaches to contact their teams after they pick up their team materials by September 5th in the Fall and April 8th in the Spring.

They will give you all the information you will need in regards to practice times and location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time and location.

It's after September 6th and April 6th, and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please do not panic if your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. Also, some coaches

may be out of town the end of August/beginning of September. If your child has not been called by September 6th for Fall and April 6th for Spring, please log into your online account to confirm you have been placed on a team and then click on Team Page. If you have not been placed, you may email us at info@ayso803.org and we will try to reach your coach for you.

What else does my child need?

You will receive two uniform jerseys and socks. This is new this year as it is a separate fee than the registration fee. You have the option to purchase additional jerseys and socks.

In addition, you may need to obtain shoes (non-metal cleats), shin guards (required), a soccer ball (size depends on division) and a water bottle.

How often are practices and games?

Practices are held once or twice a week (field and times to be determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Monday, Tuesday or Thursday evenings and Saturdays, with most teams playing their first games on September 10th. All games are held at Eau Claire Soccer Park.

Refund?

Players withdrawing prior to July 15th for Fall and February 15th for Spring, will receive a refund. The national \$20.00 fees non-refundable. All requests for a refund must be submitted on a Refund Request Form and accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope. Mail to CVSL P.O. Box 1829 Eau Claire, WI 54702-1829. If the League cancels a team, session, or season after these dates – refunds will be given in the form of credits to be used for future seasons.

Late registration?

Late registration begins after July 15th for Fall and February 15th for Spring. Registration Fees increase \$5.00. See our web site <http://ayso803.org> for our Late Registration Policy.
